- Set up in 2000
- 7,108 full-time undergraduates
- 874 full-time and part-time postgraduates (of which 75 are PhD)
- 329 full-time faculty



Objectives of InK

- To create visibility and raise the impact of the research output of SMU
- To provide organisation and access for the research output and institutional records
- To catalyse collaboration and sharing across disciplines, institutions and industry

In the Workflow

- SMU has a in-house system to capture the research output of faculty
- Called Research Publications System (RPS)
- Library is the business owner
- Maintenance by SMU Integrated Information Technology Services (IITS)

Library

In the beginning ...

- Started building the site August 2010 using Digital Commons platform
- Launched officially on 18 January 2011

- Total no of items ~ 8,000
- Total no of items with full text ~ 600 (7.5%)



Work Plans

- Increase full text articles in InK
- Increase profiles in Faculty Gallery
- Change citation in InK to better reflect document type, focusing on journal articles



Success # 1

- Using research librarians to ask faculty for their full text ¹
- In 2012 May to Dec, increased full text by 460 to have 1467 items with full text
- Research librarians continue to ask new and existing faculty

Success # 2

- Vice-Provost for Research helped promote InK to faculty
- Faculty approached Library to upload his full text
- Added 20 full text items
- Increased his downloads in the next month
- Working with faculty to encourage his colleagues to upload their full text

Kyriakos Mouratidis is an Assistant Professor at the School of Information Systems at Singapore Management University (SMU). He received the B.Sc. degree from the Computer Science Department at Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH) in 2002, and the Ph.D. degree from the Department of Computer Science and Engineering at Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (HKUST) in 2006. His main research area is spatial and spatiotemporal databases, with a focus on continuous query processing, road network databases, and spatial optimization problems. He has also worked on preference-based queries, wireless broadcasting systems, and outsourced database authentication. He has published at and been involved in the programme committees of most major database conferences, including SIGMOD and ICDE. At SMU he teaches Data Management (IS202) and Advanced Data Management (IS410).








Growth in Items

Total No. of Items




Growth in Full Text


Number of Items with Full Text



Growth in Downloads




Downloads Monthly




Downloads per Full Text Item


