- 3 large collaboration tables and 3 individual carrels
- 23-inch screens for better display of financial data —
- "Show Me" video-switching system for projection

A space for experiential learning

- experience with a large range of financial and business databases
- Prepares students for the workplace, where different companies may have access to only selected databases
- Collaboration with faculty: bridges the gap between theory and real world
- Teaching space for small groups of students
