Plant-a-Coral Seed-a-Reef

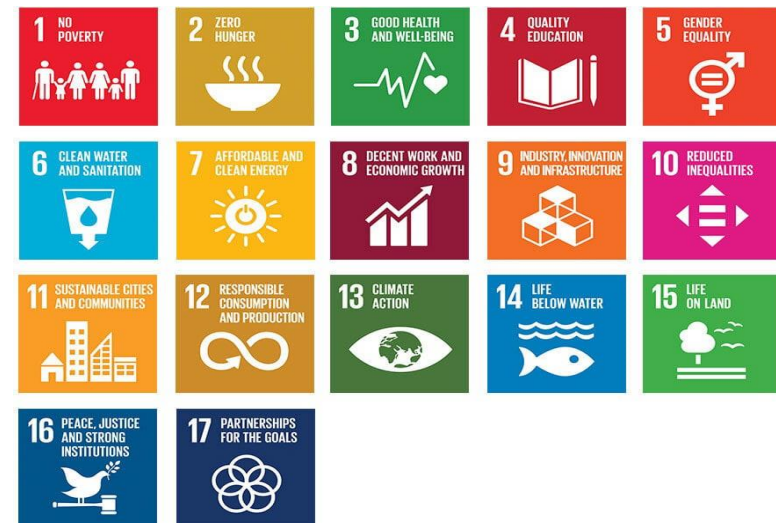
Plant-a-Coral, Seed-a-Reef Programme

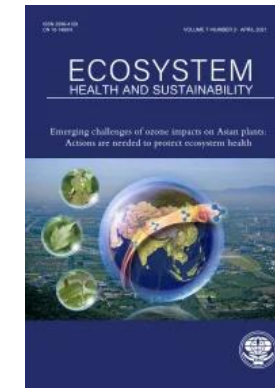
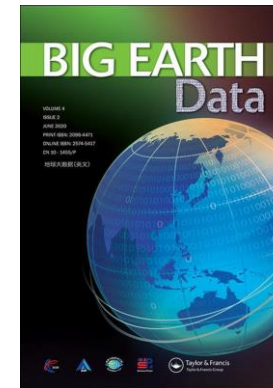
