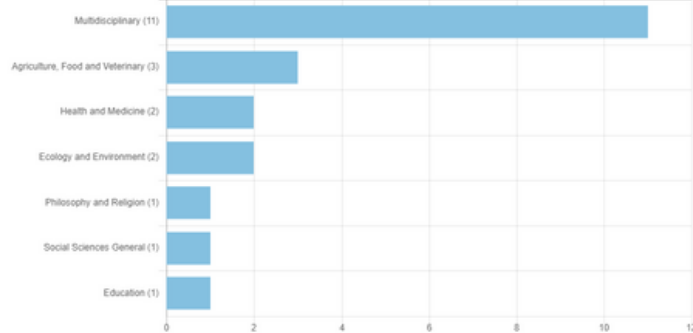

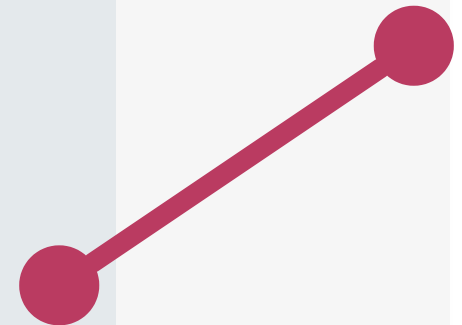
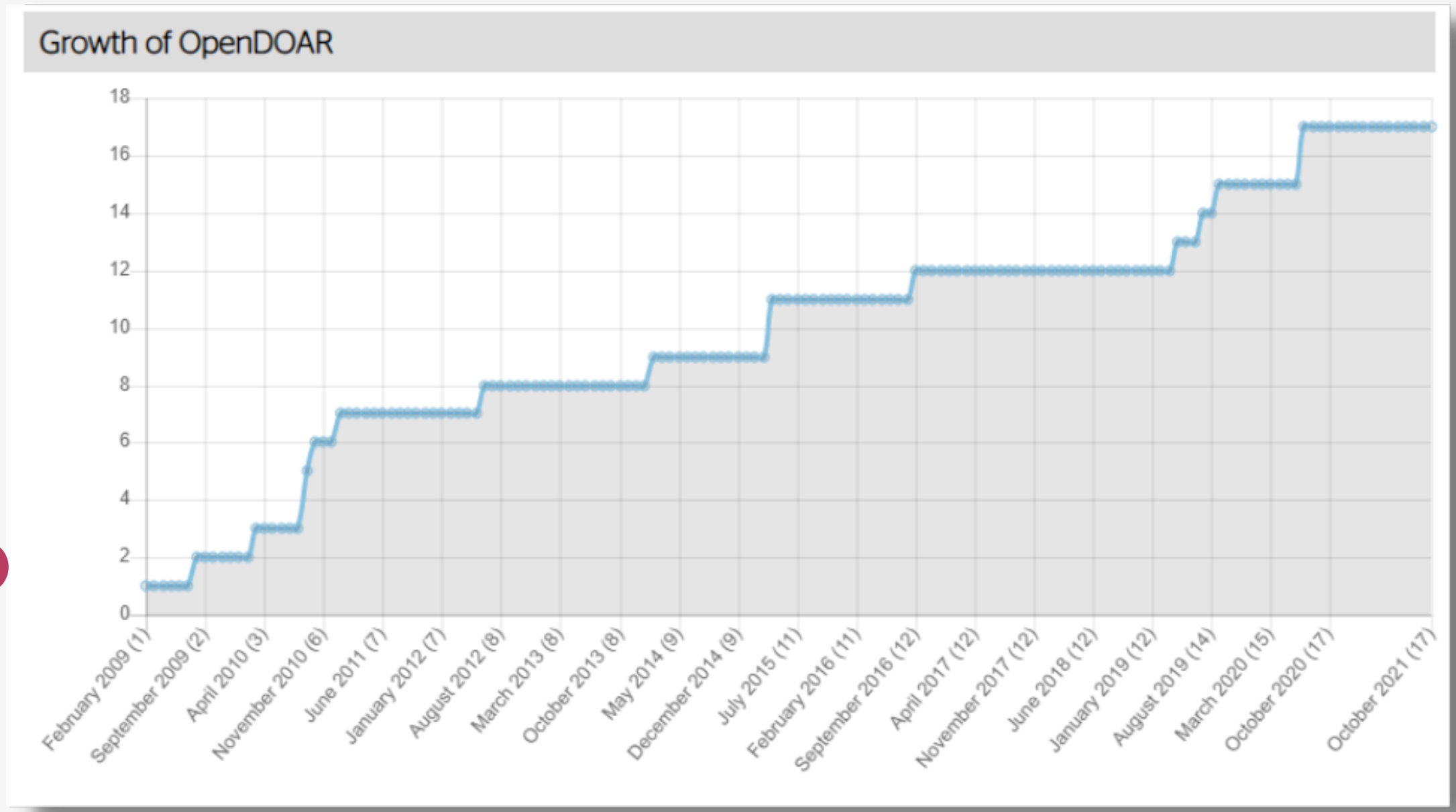
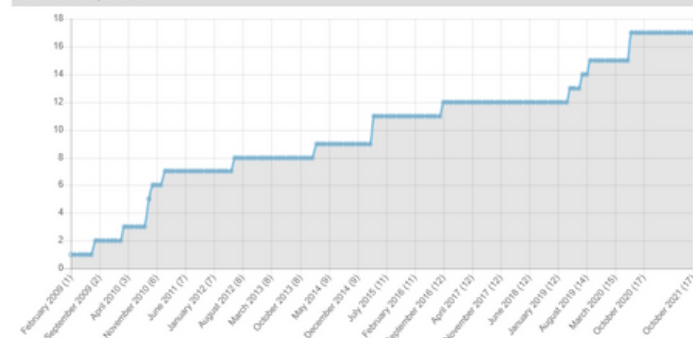
Software Platforms Overview

IR development in Thai universities



 University libraries are responsible for the establishment, maintenance, and services of IRs

 DSpace, an IR software, is mostly used.

 Mandatory and voluntary policies for recruiting IR content

 Librarians as content depositors.

2005 - 2010

Adoption and implementation

- A small number of universities established the IRs.
- Understanding on institutional repositories, open access, and intellectual property rights and copyrights
- Theses and dissertations
- Services: small access restrictions

1st period

2005 - 2010

Challenges

- Seeking for advocates from administrative level and faculty members
- Technical challenges
- Collection development
 - Digitization
 - Faculty members' acceptance
- Copyright management issues

2nd period

2011 - 2015

Increased adoption and acceptance

- An increasing number of universities gradually established the IRs.
- Increased IR awareness and perception
- Theses and dissertations and other content types
- Services: No access restriction
- TNRR - Thai National Research Repository

2nd period

2011 - 2015

Challenges

- Technical challenges - An integrated system, interoperability, etc.
- Collection development

2016 - Now

Aligning practices with global standards
